

The aircraft flooring range also meets FAA requirements FAR 25.853a (12-second vertical flammability test) and FAR 25.793 (factor of sliding friction). All product lines in the aircraft collections come with GreenMedic and GreenAir, which are both exclusive to Lonseal. GreenMedic is an antimicrobial

formulation that improves infection control, while GreenAir provides low VOC for improved cabin air quality.

Lonseal has supplied the aviation industry for over 30 years. The company has a wide range of commercial flooring products, many of which it has modified to meet all applicable aviation safety and performance requirements. Lonseal became an aviation industry leader because of the Featherweight feature in its aircraft flooring products, which makes them up to 30% lighter than standard NTF (non-textile flooring) products. In addition to the lightweight material, the high strength-to-weight ratio of the products is often specified by many aircraft designers and airplane manufacturers.
