## **APPLICATION:**

- 1. Apply the adhesive to the substrate only using a 3/8 in. (9.5 mm) nap roller.
- 2. Allow the adhesive to develop a slight tack before placing the Londeck. Do not allow the adhesive to dry. If the adhesive dries before placement of the material, an additional layer of adhesive may be applied. Lonseal is not responsible for telegraphing or displacement of too much adhesive, or for poor bond due to insufficient adhesive.
- 3. Lay the Londeck into the adhesive and roll in both directions with a minimum 100 lb. (45.4 kg), three-section roller.
- 4. Allow no foot traffic for a period of 24 hours after the installation, and allow 72 hours for the adhesive to fully cure, before setting heavy furnishings or allowing heavy traffic.

<u>CLEAN UP:</u> Promptly clean any adhesive from the flooring material and tools with warm, soapy water while the adhesive is still fresh/wet. Cured adhesive may be removed from the flooring and tools using mineral spirits applied to a clean, dry cloth. <u>Always use caution when working with mineral spirits.</u>

**LIMITATIONS:** For exterior installations only. Protect from freezing. Avoid prolonged exposure to low temperatures and do not exceed five freeze/thaw cycles. Use only when the substrate temperature is 65 °F – 85 °F (18.3 °C – 29.4 °C).
